The tournament will be held on Portsmouth Island starting at 6:00am on Friday and ending at 12:00 noon on Sunday (Weigh-in starts at 11:00am and must be in line no later than noon for your catch to be entered). Members aged 12-18 can fish the tournament by paying the entry fee and are eligible for the cash prizes. Youth members under 12 can fish (no fee) and receive a non-cash award. The categories will be Red Drum, Black Drum, Bluefish, Sea Trout and Sea Mullet. If Flounder is legal to catch during tournament period, they will take the place of Sea Trout. The Blue Ox side bet for the tournament will be the largest fish other than the species listed above and is included in your entry fees. Lunch will be served after the weigh-in.

The tournament fish categories will be Red Drum, Black Drum, Bluefish, Sea Trout and Sea Mullet. If Flounder is legal to harvest during our tournament, it will take the place of Sea Trout. The Blue Ox side bet for the tournament will be the largest fish other than the species listed above. (included in the \$50.00 entry fee).
